#### **President:**

#### **Coaches Report:**

Off season league is going well. We still only received 2 checks for helmet orders. Players have been reminded at practices and Nate has email parents' multiple times. After December 1 the price goes up \$100. Spring Season game dates are almost complete. We should need 8 buses throughout the season for transportation to away games.

#### **Other items:**

Fan Gear: It was suggested that we look into using Squad Locker for our fan gear purchases. Girls Lacrosse using them. This is a site that can be open for purchasing all year and the

merchandise is shipped directly to the buyer. We can also get a small cut for our team. Ken is going to look into this.

Upcoming Dates:

- a. Mammoth Game – 1/25; Beach Party Theme Night. It was decided to keep the ticket price at \$29. This allows us to make \$11 on each ticket. We would like to have our team sit together this year. Danika will work on this.
- b. Qdoba – Season Kick off night – 2/28; Danika working with Qdoba to confirm this date. But it looks like a go.
- c. Banquet – 5/11; The contract and deposit will be turned in this week. Nate asked if the idea of two banquets was appealing. A formal Varsity banquet as we do now and a more informal JV banquet. Some other teams do this. This topic was discussed and ultimately disliked.
- d. Ram Nation 1/18 – The principle announced that she would like to see clubs and sports teams to “sponsor” a table at this event. If boosters paid for a table it would be hard to determine who would be chosen to go. Danika will ask how to go about this at the Ram Nation meeting tomorrow night.
- e. Sunrise Scrimmage – 3/7; Heidi Domogala is the lead on this event.

Spring Fees: Should we raise them? We have buses to pay for this year and we are not doing as much fundraising. This topic was discussed and was voted on. Our new spring fee will be \$225. That is a \$25 increase.

Preseason game with VMS? Nate said only if our winter league finishes up in time. We will know more in January.

Social Media: Do we have a Facebook page? Yes, Cindy has set one up. Ken and Michelle Bourne work on getting our social media presence up.
